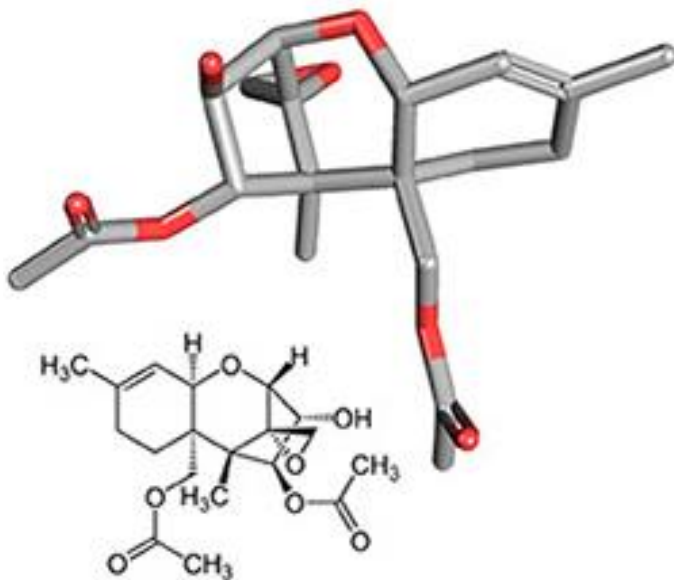




DIACETOXYSCIRPENOL (DAS)

Diacetoxyscirpenol is a mycotoxin produced by several *Fusarium* species. All domestic animals are susceptible to poisoning by dietary intake of T-2, HT-2, and DAS.



Good to know:

- This group of mycotoxins, produced by *Fusarium poae* and *F. sporotrichoides*, were associated with Alimentary Toxic Aleukia (ATA), a disease that killed thousands of people in the USSR in 1913, and in the Ukraine from 1940 to 1947.
- Field outbreaks of haemorrhagic bowel syndrome and death of some animals is typically associated with the combination of T-2 toxin, HT-2 toxin and DAS.
